Background

In 2012, the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) adopted rules mandated by the conflict minerals disclosure provisions of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. These rules require publicly-traded companies to report annually on the source and chain of custody of conflict minerals in products manufactured by the company.

Conflict Minerals Policy

Red Rock Technologies supports taking responsible steps to ensure that the products received from our supply chain are responsibly sourced. Among these include the establishment of a conflict minerals compliance program which is designed to follow the framework established by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD).

Our supplier contracts will include conflict mineral due diligence and reporting requirements. As defined in the SEC's conflict minerals rule, Red Rock Technologies' sourcing of gold, titanium, tin and tungsten will only come from conflict-free sources. Additionally, should we become aware of instances where minerals in our supply chain potentially finance armed groups as defined in the SEC's conflict minerals rule, we will work with our suppliers to find an alternative conflict-free source.
